## A school built around the child.

Open Learning grew, organically, out of homeschoolers and students who'd been told elsewhere there wasn't a place for them. No investors, no outside backers — a small team, a building in Benitachell, and a way of teaching we believed in.

- **We start with the child.** Many families find us because a bigger international school turned their child away for needing a little extra. We were built for exactly those children.
- **Small on purpose.** The goal was never to fit as many children as possible at the highest fee — it was to help as many as we can, really well.
- **Placed by level & readiness,** not by birthday — so each student moves at the right pace.

● HOW WE TEACH

## Four *commitments* we don't compromise on.

*We borrowed the best ideas we could find – the Harkness method, project-based learning, years of teaching kids who didn't fit elsewhere – and built a day around them.*

### The Harkness table

Lessons happen as conversations, not lectures. A teacher and 10–12 students discuss a stimulus — and understanding emerges from the discussion.

### Project-based learning

Real projects across subjects — marine science, enterprise, textiles, art. Life skills sit inside the curriculum, not outside it.

### Placed by level, not age

Core subjects grouped into support, middle and high. A student can be “high” for English and “support” for maths — that's normal.

### Own pace through exams

IGCSEs and A-levels stepped one at a time, taken when the student is ready. We don't set anyone up to fail.
